

Pet Fire Safety

Tips to keep your pet safe from house fires.

Extinguish Open Flames

Curious pets naturally want to investigate cooking appliances, fireplace fires and candles. Ensure your pets are not left unattended around open flames.

Pet Proof Your Home

Check for potential fire hazards - stove knobs, loose electrical wires, flammable liquids. etc.

Keep Pets Near Entrances

When leaving pets home alone, keep them in rooms near doors or windows where firefighters can easily see them. Affix a 'Pet Alert' static cling to a front window.

Use Monitored Smoke Detectors

Pets can't escape danger by themselves - these detectors alert a monitoring center to send help ASAP.

Have An Escape Plan

Practice escape routes and have a safe place to take your pet after evacuation. Always keep collars, leashes & carriers in a convenient location.
